

Peartree Knitting

For the love of all things cozy!!

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“Sunset” cushion cover (15” X 15”)



Materials:

- 150 yards of Aran weight 100% cotton yarn in navy blue
- 150 yards of Aran weight 100% cotton yarn in natural
- 150 yards of Aran weight 100% cotton yarn in orange
- US size 5 knitting needles
- Darning needle for sewing up the cushion

The amount of yarn used for this pattern is only estimated. Multiple projects have been created from the yarn therefore making it difficult to be exact. It's recommended you start each project with more yarn than what the pattern calls for.

Pattern:

Knit one row.
Purl one row.

This creates the *stockinette stitch*.

Directions:

Cast on 70 stitches with the navy blue yarn.

Using the pattern above, continue with the navy blue yarn until your piece measures 5”.

On the *same* side as your cast on “tail”, switch to the orange yarn.

Continue with the stockinette stitch (*knitting 1 row, purling 1 row*) until you have 5” of orange.

Now switch to your natural yarn on the same side as you cast on “tail” and continue with the stockinette stitch until you have **10”** with the natural yarn.

Your piece should now measure 20”.

NOTE: *You will always be changing your yarn on the same side every time there is a colour change.*

Switch to your orange yarn now and continue with the stockinette stitch until you have 5” of orange.

Finally, change to your navy yarn and continue with the stockinette stitch until you have 5” of navy.

Your piece should now measure 30”.

Tie knots in your loose strands to keep them secure. No need to weave them in as they will be on the inside of your cushion.

Fold the piece in half making sure to line up the colours and using the invisible stitch (also called the mattress stitch), seam up the 2 sides of the cushion cover.

Insert your cushion and then seam up the bottom.



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
