

Pear tree Knitting

Grass Roots Cowl

(Approximate finished size 11"W x 36"L)



Materials:

US size 10 needles

Approximately 130 yards of bulky yarn – Green

Approximately 130 yards of bulky yarn – Medium Grey

Approximately 130 yards of bulky yarn – White

Darning needle for weaving in your end.

Gauge:

Approx. 13 stitches x 22 rows = 4"

Gauge is not overly important as you will be knitting until each colour of your piece is approximately 24" long.

Directions:

This piece is knit flat and seamed at the ends.

With your green yarn, cast on 35 stitches.

Pattern:

Knit 1, Purl 1 across the entire row for every row.

Follow the above pattern (*Seed Stitch*) until your piece measures about 24" long, ending on the same side as your cast on "tail".

Tie on the medium grey yarn and continue with the knit 1, purl 1 pattern across every row until your piece measures about 48" IN TOTAL, ending on the same side as your cast on "tail".

Finally, tie on your white yarn and continue with the knit 1, purl 1 pattern across every row.

When your piece is approximately 72" IN TOTAL, cast off in pattern.

Weave in any loose ends, fold you piece in half and sew the 2 ends together.

Now get out there and enjoy the cooler weather!



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
